

Skydive Arizona Policy: Camera Jumps

- Jumping with any type of camera, including Go Pros and Contours, adds a significant element of risk to any skydive. Risks include but are not limited to:
 - Cameras falling off, creating a hazard to persons and property below.
 - Pilot chute bridles or steering lines entangling with the camera.
 - Distraction from critical safety issues such as misrouted chest straps, exit lights, freefall and canopy traffic, etc.

- The USPA recommends a minimum of 200 jumps AND instruction in camera flying prior to using a camera on any skydive. Skydive Arizona fully supports this policy.

- If you wish to jump a camera at Skydive Arizona:
 - Make the recommended 200 jumps first.
 - Familiarize yourself with the USPA's Skydiver's Information Manual, Section 6 – 8.
 - Seek advice from an experienced camera flyer.
